American Robin

Dark gray above and orange belly with a yellow bill



Northern Cardinal

This is a male cardinal. Males are red overall with a crest and black around the bill. Females are warm brown with a red tail, bill, crest, and wings.



Carolina Chickadee

Gray overall with contrasting head pattern: black cap, white cheek, and black throat



Tufted Titmouse

Gray overall with a crest and black forehead



Northern Mockingbird

Gray overall with long tail and white wing patches



House Finch

Male house finches are brown overall with streaked underside and have a red head. Females are gray-brown overall with streaks.



Eastern Bluebird

Male bluebirds are blue above with orange breast and white belly. Females have gray bodies with a light orange breast and bluish wings and tail.


Red-bellied Woodpecker

Medium-sized woodpecker with a red crown and boldly marked black and white barring on the back



Barred Owl

Brown owl with white mottling, round head, and dark eyes



Mourning Dove

Chunky brown dove with black spots on the wings



Blue Jay

Blue above and gray below with boldly marked wings and tail



Turkey Vulture

Flies with wings in a "V" shape, red head and bill with white tip



Brown Thrasher

Rusty-brown in plumage with white wingbars and streaking below



Red-tailed Hawk

Brown above and pale below, has a "bellyband" of brown feathers across a white underside. Adults have a red tail and juveniles have a thinly banded brown tail



Eastern Towhee

Black or brown above and white below with orange sides and white wing patches
